

## Oskar Olsson about Aqua4power

My name is Oskar Olsson, I'm 17 years old and lives in Skåne Fagerhult, where I grew up with mom, dad and two older sisters.

I started my career here at home in the woods on a bike without pedals at 1.5 years of age. Over time, they have been a number of different models of cross motorcycles. As an 11 year old, I won the National Championship in 85 (golden helmet). 2007 I was placed 7th in youth championships and ran two Championship races. 2008 I was 3rd in the Youth Championship and that year I drove two European Championships and a World Cup as I was drafted by the national team. In the World Cup race I got two points.

2009, I took the step up to big bike though still in the U-class and was fifth, only four pins from bronze. 2010 I upgrade to junior and in mid-season I qualify as elite riders and took three points. 2011 began a little more uneven with 18-17 seats in first SM in Vissefjärda. In Tibro following results: 20-12.

During the break between races, I have increased the training dose. I became, associated with this, recommended to drink Aqua4Power to reduce recovery time and clear out waste products that are formed in the body during strenuous physical exercise.

This made me feel stronger when the third race was held in Finspång, which are among the most physically demanding courses in Sweden. I felt a big difference especially at the end of the heats where I had more energy left than usual and could run at full speed to finish line. My final lap, in time, matched the 2 fastest World Cup riders and I felt super strong.

The results that followed were two 6<sup>th</sup> places, which my sponsors and I see as very positive!

The recovery between heats are quicker and my body feels more efficient than it did before I started drinking **Aqua4Power**.

My family and I have also noticed that my acne almost completely disappeared. Thru these lines I want to describe the positive impact that I and my surroundings have notice since I started drinking your product.
